### **Course Description**

This course is a four (8) hour program structured to furnish individuals with a short introduction to confined spaces. The student will learn the permit/non-permit requirements of confined space, potential hazards found in a confined space and an introduction to air monitors and lowering and retrieval systems. This class is designed to comply with OSHA 29, CFR 1910.146 and MIOSHA Rule 90.

### **Student Learning Outcome:**

1. Students will demonstrate knowledge in awareness of the legislation applying to Confined spaces working principles and Hazards. Students will demonstrate the ability to extricate a trapped victim in a confined space.

### **BEHAVIORAL OBJECTIVE**

Minimum passing score for the course is 80% according to the Confined Space Instructor Guide.
