Course Description: ESL 061 is designed for beginning level students to provide additional review, practice and instruction in basic vocabulary. Course Objectives:

Students will be able to ...

- 1. Classify vocabulary by part of speech.
- 2. Accurately spell 20 words a week through dictation.
- 3. Recognize, respond to and produce questions and answer in sentences with target vocabulary words both orally and in writing.

Students Learning Outcome (SLO's):

Outcome #1: Identify main ideas through picture, graph, chart, title analysis and reading comprehension.

Outcome #2: Will be able to demonstrate the knowledge of spelling rules in English.
